To join or continue in our mission to provide charity to Christians in need, spread awareness about the truth and hope of Jesus Christ, and defend religious liberty, please consider the following methods of donating:

Lifetime Giving Options

- 1. <u>Online Donations</u>. One-time or recurring donations can be made online at our website: https://missionofhopeandmercy.org/donate/
- 2. <u>Cash or Check</u>. We accept cash and checks made payable to *Apostolate of Our Lady of Hope*. Checks can be mailed to: Apostolate of Our Lady of Hope, 2459 S. Chase Lane, Lakewood, Colorado 80227.
- 3. <u>Contribution of Stocks or Securities</u>. Donating appreciated stocks or securities to Apostolate of Our Lady of Hope can be a tax-efficient way to support our mission.
- 4. Qualified Charitable Distribution (QCD) from IRA. Individuals 70-½ and older can rollover funds directly from their IRA account to Apostolate of Our Lady of Hope.
- 5. Charitable Remainder Trust. A Charitable Remainder Trust (CRT) provides you with an immediate tax deduction and allows you (or others that you name as beneficiaries) to receive an income for life or for a specified term of years. After being established via irrevocable transfer of assets into the trust, the CRT retains all assets (less income payments to beneficiaries) until the specified term ends or the death of the beneficiary; whatever funds remain in the trust at that time transfer to Apostolate of Our Lady of Hope.

Planned Giving Options

- 6. <u>Charitable Bequest</u>. A donor can work with his or her estate planning attorney to leave property to Apostolate of Our Lady of Hope via bequest made in his or her will or living/revocable trust. A bequest is easy to establish and can be made with many different types of assets, including but not limited to cash, securities, real estate, and precious metals or jewelry.
- 7. <u>Beneficiary Designation</u>. Naming Apostolate of Our Lady of Hope as the beneficiary of the proceeds of one or more life insurance policies, retirement accounts, bank accounts or similar asset upon your death. It is a relatively quick and simple matter of listing Apostolate of Our Lady of Hope as a full or partial beneficiary on the designation form associated with all such assets.
