1. Strategic Partnership with Oum Nour (January 10, 2025)

The collaboration with Oum Nour marked a pivotal moment in our ongoing effort to combat drug addiction and support recovery.

The team at Oum Nour visited our Vital Center for Blessings to further solidify our shared mission.

They successfully collected 1,866 pounds of essential food items to support their efforts, reinforcing our commitment to the community's well-being.



This partnership highlights the critical role the Center plays in enabling life-changing work through practical resources and steadfast support.

2. Center for Blessings Gathering (January 11, 2025)

The gathering at the Center for Blessings brought over 40 individuals together for a day of connection, joy, and shared purpose.

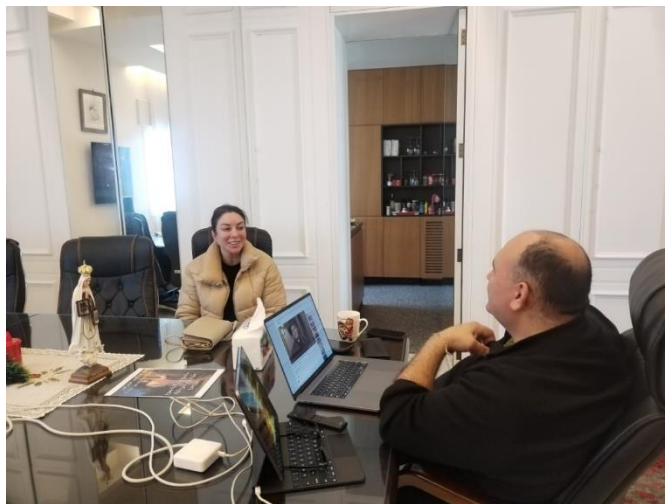

3. Health Advocacy Collaboration with La Chaîne de l'Espoir (January 7, 2025)

On January 7, we hosted Daniel Greige from La Chaîne de l'Espoir, an organization focused on improving pediatric healthcare.



Our discussion centered on raising awareness about critical health issues such as congenital anomalies and infantile pathologies in Lebanon.

By leveraging the Center for Blessings as a platform for outreach, we look forward to collaborating on campaigns and awareness sessions that empower the community to act on behalf of vulnerable children, ensuring they receive timely medical care and support.

4. Continued Support to Caritas Lebanon (January 15, 2025)

On January 15, our mission continued its commitment to food security and support services by providing 35 food boxes to Caritas Lebanon, totaling 1,188 pounds of essentials.

Caritas, a crucial ally in reaching Lebanon's most vulnerable communities, received these donations at our Center for Blessings, underscoring our center's role as a vital hub for providing resources to partner organizations.

This partnership helps ensure that aid reaches even the most remote areas, directly benefiting Lebanese citizens and refugees alike.



5. Emergency Financial Assistance to Cancer Patient (January 20, 2025)



A request from cancer patient Ms. Yollande Mezher for urgent financial assistance was swiftly addressed by our team. By covering the cost of a critical radiotherapy session, we ensured that Ms. Mezher received the life-saving treatment she needed.

This intervention highlights the Mission's role in providing immediate and compassionate care to individuals in crisis, reinforcing the importance of our presence in Lebanon as a source of hope and support during life-threatening situations.

6. Ongoing Support for Widow Mrs. Hoda Dahan (January 22, 2025)



For the sixth consecutive year, the Mission of Hope and Mercy provided comprehensive support to Mrs. Hoda Dahan, a widow raising three orphaned children.

This year, we covered her 2024 rent fees, provided a month's supply of essential medications, and supplied a heater for the winter months.

Additionally, we ensured that she had a full month's supply of food. The Mission's dedication to supporting families like Mrs. Dahan's underscores the long-term impact of our presence, demonstrating our ongoing commitment to alleviating suffering and providing stability.

7. Medical Assistance to the Farah Family (January 29, 2025)

For the second consecutive year, the Mission of Hope and Mercy provided essential medical support to the Farah family. Our generous contribution of \$1,000 covered a full month's supply of Omnitrope medication for sisters Angie and Christa Farah, both of whom struggle with growing deficiencies.

The center's involvement in providing medical care reinforces its importance as a hub of compassion, where both immediate and long-term needs are met, offering families the hope they need to face health challenges.



8. Food Boxes AID/Detergent Bags (January, 2025)

In addition to our ongoing efforts, we are pleased to share that 5 food boxes were delivered to 5 different families in need.

These boxes, stocked with essentials such as beans, pasta, oil, and canned food, are designed to provide food supplies for over a month.

A family also received with the food box two detergent bags.



The food boxes along with the detergent bags are stored at our Vital Center for Blessings, ensuring they are easily accessible to families experiencing food insecurity. This initiative is part of our ongoing commitment to support and uplift those in need in our community.
