

## **Monthly Report – May 2025**

---

### **Executive Summary:**

In May 2025, the Mission of Hope and Mercy reaffirmed its role as a crucial lifeline for vulnerable individuals in Lebanon through targeted Medical Aid. On May 27, the Mission responded for the third time to the urgent needs of the Farah family, providing \$1,000 to fund a full month of Omnitrope medication for Angie and Christa Farah, who suffer from growth deficiencies.

On May 28, the Mission provided a second intervention this year for cancer patient Ms. Yollande Mezher, covering a \$400 radiotherapy session that was critical to her survival. These actions reflect our deep commitment to offering immediate, compassionate, and impactful support to individuals in life-threatening medical crises.

### **1. Key Activities and Support Provided:**

1. **Medical Aid:** For the second consecutive year and for the Third time this year, on Tuesday May 27, 2025 the Mission of Hope and Mercy provided essential medical support to the Farah family.



Our generous contribution of \$1,000 covered a full month's supply of Omnitrope medication for sisters Angie and Christa Farah, both of whom struggle with growing deficiencies.

2. **Medical Aid:** A second request this year from cancer patient Ms. Yollande Mezher for urgent financial assistance was swiftly addressed by our team, bringing a total of \$400 that covered the cost of a critical radiotherapy session, we ensured Ms. Mezher received the life-saving treatment she urgently needed.



This continued intervention underscores the Mission's unwavering commitment to providing immediate and compassionate care to individuals in crisis, reinforcing the importance of our presence in Lebanon as a vital source of hope and support during life-threatening situations.

## **2. Impact on Beneficiaries:**

- **Medical Aid to Farah Family (May 27):** A \$1,000 donation covered Omnitrope treatment for Angie and Christa Farah, ensuring continued care for their growth deficiencies and alleviating the financial burden on their family.
- **Medical Aid to Yollande Mezher (May 28):** In response to a second request this year, the Mission provided an additional \$400 in financial assistance to cancer patient Ms. Yollande Mezher, covering a critical radiotherapy session. This support ensured access to life-saving treatment and reflects our ongoing commitment to compassionate care in crisis situations. Her life was under threat if it wasn't for the Mission of Hope and Mercy who jumped in and paid the full amount



### **3. Challenges and Areas for Growth:**

- **Sustained Funding Needs:** The recurring nature of critical medical cases like those of the Farah girls and Ms. Mezher highlights the need for stable and increased donor engagement to sustain ongoing medical support.
  - **Expanding Medical Partnerships:** Establishing partnerships with local healthcare providers and pharmacies could help secure discounted medication and treatment services, maximizing the impact of our funds.
  - **Volunteer and Local Staff Expansion:** Strengthening our on-ground presence through volunteers or local staff could enhance our response time and improve personal engagement with beneficiaries.
  - **Raising Awareness:** There remains a need to increase public awareness about the Mission's efforts in Lebanon to attract more support and foster community involvement in our initiatives.
