

Monthly Report – October 2025

Executive Summary:

In October 2025, the Mission of Hope and Mercy continued its commitment to supporting vulnerable communities in Lebanon through its ongoing humanitarian programs. The main focus this month was the delivery of essential food aid to *Oum Nour*, contributing significantly to the rehabilitation and well-being of individuals battling addiction.

1. Key Activities and Support Provided:

• Food Aid Distribution – October 2025:

As part of our quarterly assistance, the Mission of Hope and Mercy donated **1,350 food items** weighing approximately **1,697 pounds**.



The items included beans, pasta, rice, and canned goods, which were distributed to support the *Oum Nour Center* in its mission to provide nutrition and care for patients undergoing rehabilitation.



This contribution aligns with our continued objective to support community-based initiatives that directly impact the health, stability, and recovery of individuals in need.



2. <u>Impact on Beneficiaries:</u>

The food boxes provided by the Mission of Hope and Mercy have played a crucial role in sustaining the *Oum Nour Center's* capacity to feed its patients under rehabilitation. This assistance helps ensure that patients receive the

necessary nutrition to complete their treatment successfully.

Beyond physical nourishment, this act of support also strengthens community awareness regarding substance abuse prevention and the social factors contributing to addiction.
