



Monthly Report – August 2025

Executive Summary:

In September 2025, the Mission of Hope and Mercy continued its efforts to support vulnerable populations in Lebanon through targeted food aid programs. During this month, the Mission distributed 3 food boxes to families in need, ensuring they had access to sufficient nutrition to meet their daily needs. Additionally, the Mission provided critical food supplies to the Marian Kitchen, led by Fr. Hany Tawk at the Beirut Seaport, supporting the preparation and delivery of meals for hundreds of homeless children and families. These initiatives demonstrate the Mission's ongoing commitment to alleviating hunger, strengthening community resilience, and partnering with local organizations to address the needs of the most disadvantaged members of society.

1.Key Activities and Support Provided:

- **Food Aid Distribution – September 2025:**

During the month of September, the Mission provided 3 food boxes to families in need, ensuring that they had access to sufficient nutrition and essential supplies to support their daily needs.

- **Food Aid Distribution – September 2025(Mariam Kitchen):**

In response to the needs of the Marian Kitchen, led by Fr. Hany Tawk at the Beirut Seaport, the Mission of Hope and Mercy provided essential food supplies to support the preparation and delivery of meals for hundreds of homeless children and families in great need.



Items Delivered:

- Cheese: 59 boxes (52 lbs)
- Vermicelli: 5 bags (55 lbs)

Total Weight: 107 lbs

Fr. Hany Tawk, CEO of the Marian Kitchen, acknowledged receipt of this donation, affirming that the contribution directly assists their daily operations in feeding the most vulnerable through their Soup Kitchen in Beirut near the seaport.

This initiative reflects our mission to fight hunger, restore dignity, and serve the poor through grassroots partnerships with local community leaders.



1. Impact on Beneficiaries:

The food aid provided in September directly supported families and individuals experiencing food insecurity, ensuring they had access to nutritious meals to sustain their daily needs. The 3 food boxes distributed to families helped alleviate immediate hunger and provided essential support for their households.
