What did we do with your funds?

In December of 2020 we have helped the Chaldean community in Beirut celebrating their annual Christmas food and children gifts Celebration.

In January and February 2021, we have purchased 1045 boxes of Food, enough for 1045 families and the food is being safely distributed by local volunteers including priests, monks and nuns.

In January 2021, we have helped a local family in Denver to furnish their home with all kind of needs.

In January 2021, we have paid fully for an emergency surgery for a father and provider of a family in Northern Iraq, near Dahock. He is recovering beautifully and we are in touch with him and his wife and children.

In February 2021, we have purchased 4 major Oxygen Machines and put them in use for local mountains and midrange mountains villages and towns, where a population of over 60 thousand people is locked in, and suffering the outcome of the savage Covid19 and extreme poverty and famine.

In March 2021, we will be purchasing another 6 major Oxygen machines to be dedicated to the service of the Red Cross, the Civil Defense (Lebanon Fire Department Agency) and the Archdiocese of Jbeil In the Region of Mount Lebanon to help treating the sick people with Covid and save them from taking a turn to the worse and to a potential death. With total 10 Oxygen machines, we are able to serve at least 50 patients per week.

In March 2021, from now we have reserved and are looking forward to distribute another 500 boxes of food for 500 families in Beirut which include refugees from Iraq, Syria and poor people from Lebanon through our work with the Syriac Orthodox Church of Mount Lebanon.

MORE TO COME, MORE IS NEEDED. THANK YOU FOR YOUR TRUST AND I THANK GOD FOR ALLOWING US TO SERVE HIM IN THE POOR, THE NEEDY, THE SICK, THE OPPRESSED, AND THE REFUGEE.




